



Score Posting to the Handicap System for GSGA Competitions

A "tournament score" is a score made in a competition organized and conducted by the committee in charge of the competition. The competition must identify a winner(s) based on a stipulated round(s), and must be played under the principles of the Rules of Golf.

All players are responsible for posting their scores to the handicap system upon conclusion of all GSGA competitions. Scores must be posted as tournament (T) scores. Course slope and rating information is typically posted at the scoreboard during the competition. However, you may also contact GSGA for this information. Your scores are always subject to review by your peers and your club's handicap committee.
