

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION - The following conditions shall be in effect for this competition:

- GSGA competitions are "spikeless" events. Therefore, metal and traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.
- Players are responsible for posting their scores to the handicap system upon conclusion of this competition. Scores must be posted as tournament scores. Course slope and rating information is typically posted at the scoreboard during the competition. You may also contact GSGA for this information. Your scores are subject to review by your peers and your club's handicap committee.

COMPETITION	Girls' Championship
ELIGIBILITY	Open to female amateur golfers between the ages of 9-18. Entrants must be at least 9 years old on or before the first day of the Championship (June 19) and must not have reached their 19th birthday before the last day of the Championship (June 21). Entrants must have a GSGA handicap index.
FIELD	Low 144 entries by USGA Handicap Index.
FORMAT	54 holes of flighted, individual stroke play.
PRACTICE ROUNDS	<p>Practice rounds will be available on the designated times below prior to the competition. Players may call Georgia Southern University Golf Course to reserve a practice round starting time beginning June 5. Carts will be available for rental during the practice round by parents or players with a valid driver's license at a cost of \$30. Cash and credit cards will be accepted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anytime, based on availability
YARDAGES & TEES	A practice yardage sheet will be available after the close of entries on the GSGA event details page on the website. Practice yardage sheets will also be available at the club. Yardages are approximate and may be adjusted due to inclement weather or other factors that may affect the playing conditions during the competition.
GOLF SHOP & DRIVING RANGE:	The golf shop and driving range will open at 7:00 a.m. each day of competition.
STARTING TIMES	Starting times for tournament play will be assigned by the GSGA and posted at the club the day before the competition starts. You may visit www.gsga.org for complete pairing information and starting times beginning June 12.
REGISTRATION	No formal registration will be held on site.
CADDIES	All players must walk and carry their own bag or may use a pull cart. Caddies are specifically prohibited. Pull carts are permitted.
RULES OF PLAY/PACE OF PLAY/SPECTATOR CART POLICY	The GSGA Rules of Play, Pace of Play and Spectator Cart Policy for Junior Competitions shall be in effect. Click here to view the GSGA Rules of Play and Pace of Play Policies. Spectators may rent carts during the competition rounds at a cost of \$30 per cart seat. The number of carts allowed for rental to spectators will be limited to two carts per group and no more than two people will be allowed per cart. The overall number of

	spectator carts rented is subject to change based on availability. Cash and credit cards will be accepted.
DRESS CODE	Proper golf attire must be worn in all phases of this Championship. No tank tops, tee shirts, or blue jeans will be allowed. Competitors must be neat in respect to personal grooming and clothing.
PLAYER HOSPITALITY	The GSGA cordially invites all players and families to an evening cookout in their honor on Monday, June 19. Details to follow after the close of entries.
FOOD SERVICE	Food service will be available each day. Cash and credit cards will be accepted.
PRIZES	Medals will be awarded to the top finishers in each flight.
GA/SC JUNIOR CHALLENGE MATCH	The top SIX finishers in the Georgia Girls' Championship will qualify to participate in the Georgia-South Carolina Girls' Junior Challenge Match on August 5-6 at DeBordieu Club in Georgetown, SC. The 7 th and 8 th place finishers will be 1 st and 2 nd alternates. Details will be distributed at the conclusion of the championship. Players must be at least 14 years of age to qualify for the team.
