

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION - The following conditions shall be in effect for this competition:

- GSGA competitions are "spikeless" events. Therefore, metal and traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.
- Players are responsible for posting their scores to the handicap system upon conclusion of this competition. Scores must be posted as tournament scores. Course slope and rating information is typically posted at the scoreboard during the competition. You may also contact GSGA for this information. Your scores are subject to review by your peers and your club's handicap committee.

COMPETITION	Senior & Super Senior Four-Ball Championship
ELIGIBILITY	Open to two-man teams of male amateur golfers ages 55 or older as of November 8 and who have a maximum handicap differential of six strokes.
FIELD	96 teams. The 48 teams with the lowest combined USGA Handicap Indexes compete in the Championship flight; The 12 or 24 teams with the lowest combined USGA Handicap Indexes will compete in Super Senior flight(s) (ages 65 or older as of November 8); the remaining 24 teams for Senior flights are determined by lottery, up to four spots reserved for the previous year's flight winners.
FORMAT	54 holes of flighted, four-ball stroke play. ALL flights will compete at Sunset Country Club (Revised).
PRACTICE ROUNDS	<p>One practice round per player. Practice rounds will be available on the designated times below two weeks prior to the competition. After being accepted into the field, please call Sunset Country Club to reserve your practice round starting time. Practice round cart and range fee is \$30 plus tax. Cash and credit cards will be accepted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sunset Country Club: Tuesday-Thursday anytime & Friday-Sunday after 1:00 p.m.
YARDAGES & TEES	Yardages will be posted online and at the host club. Yardages are approximate and may be adjusted due to inclement weather or other factors that may affect the playing conditions during the competition.
GOLF SHOP & DRIVING RANGE:	The golf shop and driving range will open at 7:00 a.m. each day of competition.
STARTING TIMES	Starting times for tournament play will be assigned by the GSGA and posted at the clubs the day before the competition starts. You may visit www.gsga.org for complete pairing information and starting times beginning on November 3.
REGISTRATION	Informal registration will be held on site. Player/team withdraws may be called or e-mailed in to the GSGA office so that an alternate team may be contacted.

CARTS	Practice cart and range fees are \$30 plus tax. Cash and credit cards will be accepted. Tournament round cart and range fees are included in the entry fee.
