CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION - The following conditions shall be in effect for this competition:

- GSGA competitions are "spikeless" events. Therefore, metal and traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.
- Players are responsible for posting their scores to the handicap system upon conclusion of this competition. Scores must be posted as tournament scores. Course slope and rating information is typically posted at the scoreboard and on scorecards during the competition. You may also contact GSGA for this information. Your scores are subject to review by your peers and your club's handicap committee.

YARDAGES & TEES	Combinations of tee markers and yardages for the Senior division and the Super Senior division will be utilized for the Championship. A practice yardage sheet will be made available for practice rounds before the close of entries. Yardages are approximate and may be adjusted due to inclement weather or other factors that may affect the playing conditions during the competition.
GOLF SHOP & DRIVING RANGE:	The golf shop and driving range will open at 7:00 a.m. each day of competition.
