CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION - The following conditions shall be in effect for this competition:

• The player's clubs must conform to the groove specifications in *The Rules of Golf* that are effective from January 1, 2010.

PENALTY FOR CARRYING, BUT NOT MAKING STROKE WITH, CLUB OR CLUBS IN BREACH OF CONDITION: <u>Two strokes</u> for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – <u>Four strokes</u>. In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole. Any club or clubs carried in breach of this condition must be declared out of play by the player to her marker or fellow-competitor immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. If the player fails to do so, she is disqualified.

PENALTY FOR MAKING STROKE WITH CLUB IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Disqualification.

- Distance measuring devices as described in Decision 14-3/0.5 are permitted.
- GSGA competitions are "spikeless" events. Therefore, metal and traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.
- Amateur players are responsible for posting their scores to the handicap system upon conclusion of this competition. Scores must be posted as tournament scores. Course slope and rating information is typically posted at the scoreboard during the competition. You may also contact GSGA for this information. Your scores are subject to review by your peers and your club's handicap committee.

PRACTICE ROUNDS	 One practice round per player and practice rounds are for players only. Practice rounds will be available on the designated dates and times below. Please call <u>Planterra Ridge GC</u> to reserve your practice round starting time. Practice round cart and range fee is \$27 plus tax and must be paid regardless of whether or not the player chooses to walk or ride. <u>Cash or Credit Cards</u> will be the accepted method of payment in the golf shop. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, anytime based on availability Saturday – Sunday, after 1:00 p.m. based on availability
CARTS	Golf cart fees are included in your practice round fee which is \$27.00 per player. Spectator golf carts are specifically prohibited. During the qualifying round, <i>automotive transportation is permissible for the competitor</i> . Cart fees for the qualifying round are \$27.00 per person if the player chooses to use a cart. Caddies must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless exceptions are authorized on the Notice to Competitors.
YARDAGES & TEES	A yardage sheet will be available on-site and also through a link/download on the GSGA website. Yardages are approximate and may be adjusted due to inclement weather or other factors that may affect the playing conditions during the competition.

REGISTRATION	NO formal registration will be held on site. Players should arrive to their assigned starting tee ten minutes before their starting time to allow for the starter to go over instructions and rules of play. Player withdraws must be called in to the GSGA office at (770) 955-4272.
