- GSGA competitions are "spikeless" events. Therefore, metal and traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.
- Players are responsible for posting their scores to the handicap system upon conclusion of
 this competition. Scores must be posted as tournament scores. Course slope and rating
 information is typically posted at the scoreboard during the competition. You may also
 contact GSGA for this information. Your scores are subject to review by your peers and your
 club's handicap committee.

FIELD	Low 48 entries by USGA Handicap Index
	18 holes of stroke play qualifying followed by match play for 48 players in two flighted brackets. The championship bracket will consist of 32 players. Qualifying scores are for seeds in match play brackets. Match Play – 18 holes per match. The low 32 scores from stroke play qualifying will comprise the Championship flight. The remaining players will be placed in a flight of 16 based on scores from stroke play qualifying. The schedule for qualifying and match play is as follows:
FORMAT	 Wednesday, June 1: Stroke play qualifying for match play flights and seeds in a.m. Thursday, June 2: Championship bracket round of 32 in a.m., Tournament bracket round of 16 in a.m., Championship bracket round of 16 in p.m. Friday, June 3: Championship & Tournament Quarterfinals in a.m., Semifinals in p.m. Saturday, June 4: Championship & Tournament Finals in a.m.
PRACTICE ROUNDS	One practice round per player. Practice rounds will be available on the designated times below two weeks prior to the competition. Please call Sunset Hills Country Club to reserve your practice round starting time. Practice round cart and range fee is \$25 plus tax. Credit cards ONLY will be accepted. Tuesday-Thursday, anytime, based on club availability. Friday and Sunday after 1:00 p.m.
YARDAGES & TEES	A combination of tee markers and yardages will be utilized for the championship. Yardages are approximate and may be adjusted due to inclement weather or other factors that may affect the playing conditions during the competition. A complete practice yardage sheet will be provided for players playing practice rounds.
GOLF SHOP & DRIVING RANGE:	The golf shop and driving range will open at 6:30 a.m. each day of competition.
STARTING TIMES	Starting times for tournament play will be assigned by the GSGA and posted at the club the day before the competition starts. You may visit www.gsga.org for complete pairing information and starting times beginning on May 25.

REGISTRATION	No formal registration will be held on site. Player withdraws must be called or e-mailed in to the GSGA office so that an alternate may be contacted.
CARTS	Practice carts and range fees are \$25 plus tax. Credit cards ONLY will be accepted. Cart fees for the stroke play qualifying round and first round of match play for each player are included with the entry fee. Players advancing to additional matches will be responsible for an additional cart and range fee of \$25.00 tax inclusive per day. These fees will be charged to the player through the online registration system after the competition has been completed. These fees must be paid regardless of whether or not the player chooses to use a cart.
