- GSGA competitions are "spikeless" events. Therefore, metal and traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.

 this competition. Scores must be posted as tournament scores. Course slope and rating
 information is typically posted at the scoreboard during the competition. You may also

FIELD	Low 42 entries by USGA Handicap Index. **More spots will be made available for qualifying AND match play if the Senior Women's Match Play Championship does not use its maximum field allotment.
FORMAT	36 holes of stroke play qualifying followed by match play for up to 32 players in two flighted brackets. **See note above regarding additional players for qualifying and match play. Stroke play qualifying scores are for seeds in match play brackets. The low 16 scores from stroke play qualifying will comprise the Championship flight. The remaining 16 players to qualify for match play will be placed in a Tournament flight of 16. Match Play – 18 holes per match. The schedule for qualifying and match play is as follows:

PRACTICE ROUNDS	One practice round per player. Practice rounds will be available on the designated times below two weeks prior to the competition. Cash and credit cards will be accepted. • Monday, anytime, based on club availability. • Friday-Sunday, after 1:00 p.m. • Tuesday, May 30, based on availability for out of town players only.
YARDAGES & TEES	A combination of tee markers and yardages will be utilized for the championship. See the event details page for more information and a link to the practice yardage sheet. Yardages are approximate and may be adjusted due to inclement weather or other factors that may affect the playing conditions during the competition. A complete practice yardage sheet will be provided for players playing practice rounds.

GOLF SHOP & DRIVING RANGE:	The golf shop and driving range will open at 7:00 a.m. each day of competition.
