

**CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION - The following conditions shall be in effect for this competition:**

- **GSGA competitions are "spikeless" events. Therefore, metal and traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.**
- **Players are responsible for posting their scores to the handicap system upon conclusion of this competition. Scores must be posted as tournament scores. Course slope and rating information is typically posted at the scoreboard during the competition. You may also contact GSGA for this information. Your scores are subject to review by your peers and your club's handicap committee.**

<b>COMPETITION</b>	Women’s Team Championship
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	Open to two-person teams of female amateur golfers with a maximum individual USGA Handicap Index of 31.9 and a maximum team differential of eight strokes; must be 18 years old by September 19.
<b>FIELD</b>	60 teams; Teams may elect to play in a gross or net division. Field will be expanded if 80 teams enter, with a maximum of 100 teams.
<b>FORMAT</b>	36 holes, one round of flighted, four-ball gross or net stroke play and one round in scramble format
<b>PRACTICE ROUNDS</b>	<p>Practice rounds will be available on the designated times below prior to the competition. Please call <a href="#">River Forest Golf Club</a> to reserve your practice round starting time after you have received your acceptance confirmation on September 1. Practice round cart and range fee is \$25 plus tax. <b>YARDAGES &amp; TEES</b>	A combination of Green, White and Red tee markers and yardages will be utilized for the Championship Gross Division. A combination of the Green and Red tee markers and yardages will be utilized for the Net Division. Yardages will be posted to the event details page as soon as they are available. Yardages are approximate and may be adjusted due to inclement weather or other factors that may affect the playing conditions during the competition. A complete practice yardage sheet will be provided for players playing practice rounds.
<b>GOLF SHOP &amp; DRIVING RANGE:</b>	The golf shop and driving range will open at 7:30 a.m. each day of competition.
<b>STARTING TIMES</b>	Starting times for tournament play will be assigned by the GSGA and posted at the club the day before the competition starts. You may visit <a href="http://www.gsga.org">www.gsga.org</a> for complete pairing information and starting times beginning on September 14.
<b>REGISTRATION</b>	No formal registration will be held on site. <b>Player withdraws must be called or e-mailed to the GSGA office so that an alternate may be contacted.</b>

<b>CARTS</b>	Practice carts and range fees are \$25 plus tax. Tournament round cart and range fees are included in the entry fee. Cash and credit cards will be accepted.
